

March 9, 2017 was an exciting day for our office. The Supreme Court of Indiana heard Oral Arguments in regard to one of our cases where our plaintiff was awarded \$2 million in damages. The Court of Appeals reversed and remanded the case for a new trial. The Supreme Court granted our petition to transfer the case and assumed jurisdiction over the appeal. Supreme Court Justice Robert Rucker presided over the Oral Argument which was heard at the Theodore Roosevelt College and Career Academy, 730 W. 25th Ave., Gary, IN. This was to be one of the final Oral arguments that Justice Rucker would hear prior to his retirement. The auditorium was composed of over 300 spectators, including students from the Career Academy, Highland High School, Andean, Bishop Noll, Lighthouse Academy, and Merrillville High School, as well as Judges and Lawyers from the Lake County area, Porter County and St. Joseph County.
